Purpose

- Select LEED APs in the green building industry who are:
 - Exceptional
 - Influenced built environment through green design and practice

Purpose of Research

- Design a process that draws on the expertise of professionals in the green building industry
- Define the characteristics of a Fellow in terms of their knowledge, accomplishments and experience
- Lay the foundation for designing a system and processes for implementing this new designation

Development

Phase I

- Interviews with 10 thought leaders

Phase II

- Interviews with a larger sample

Phase III

- 18 Focus groups in 10 different cities

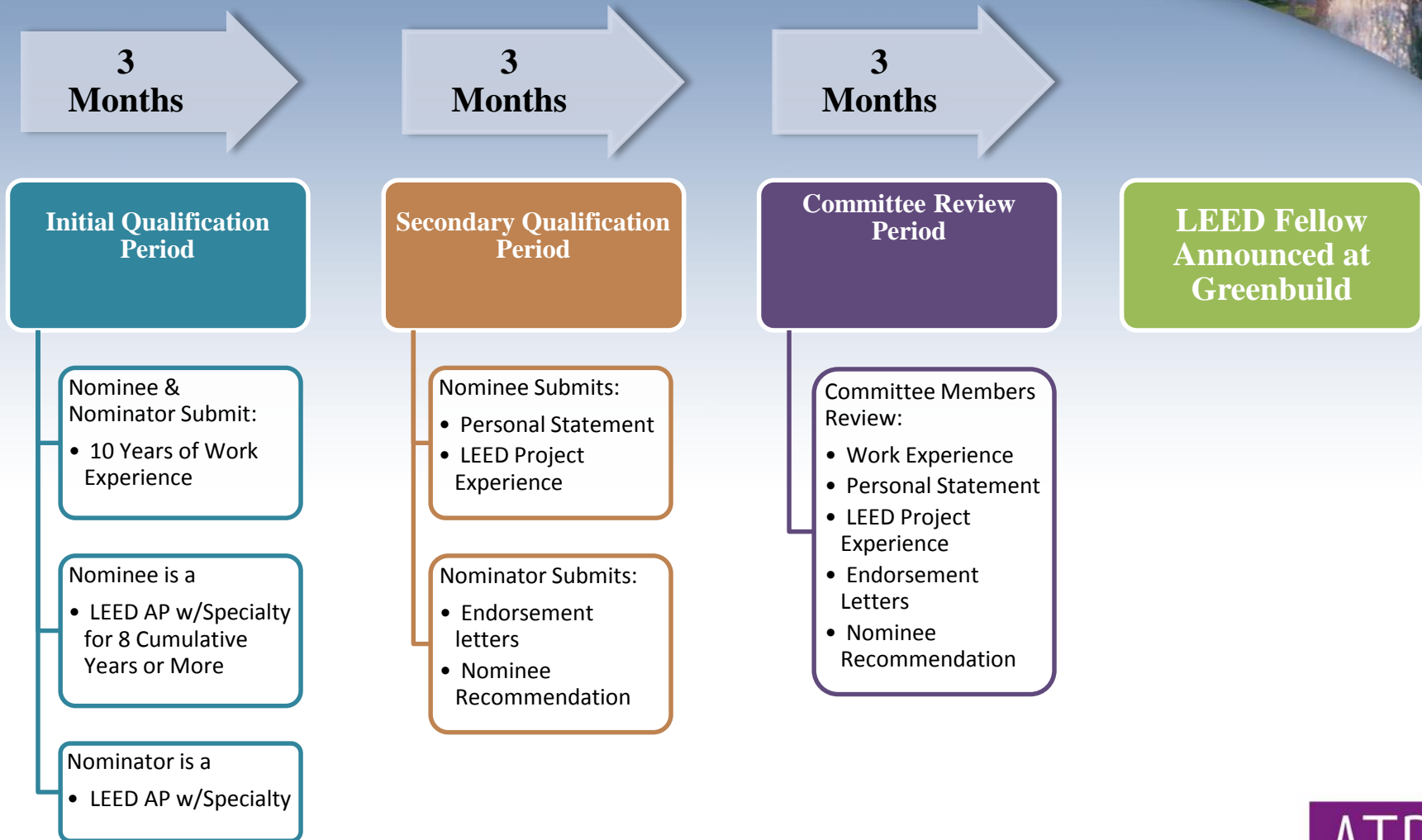

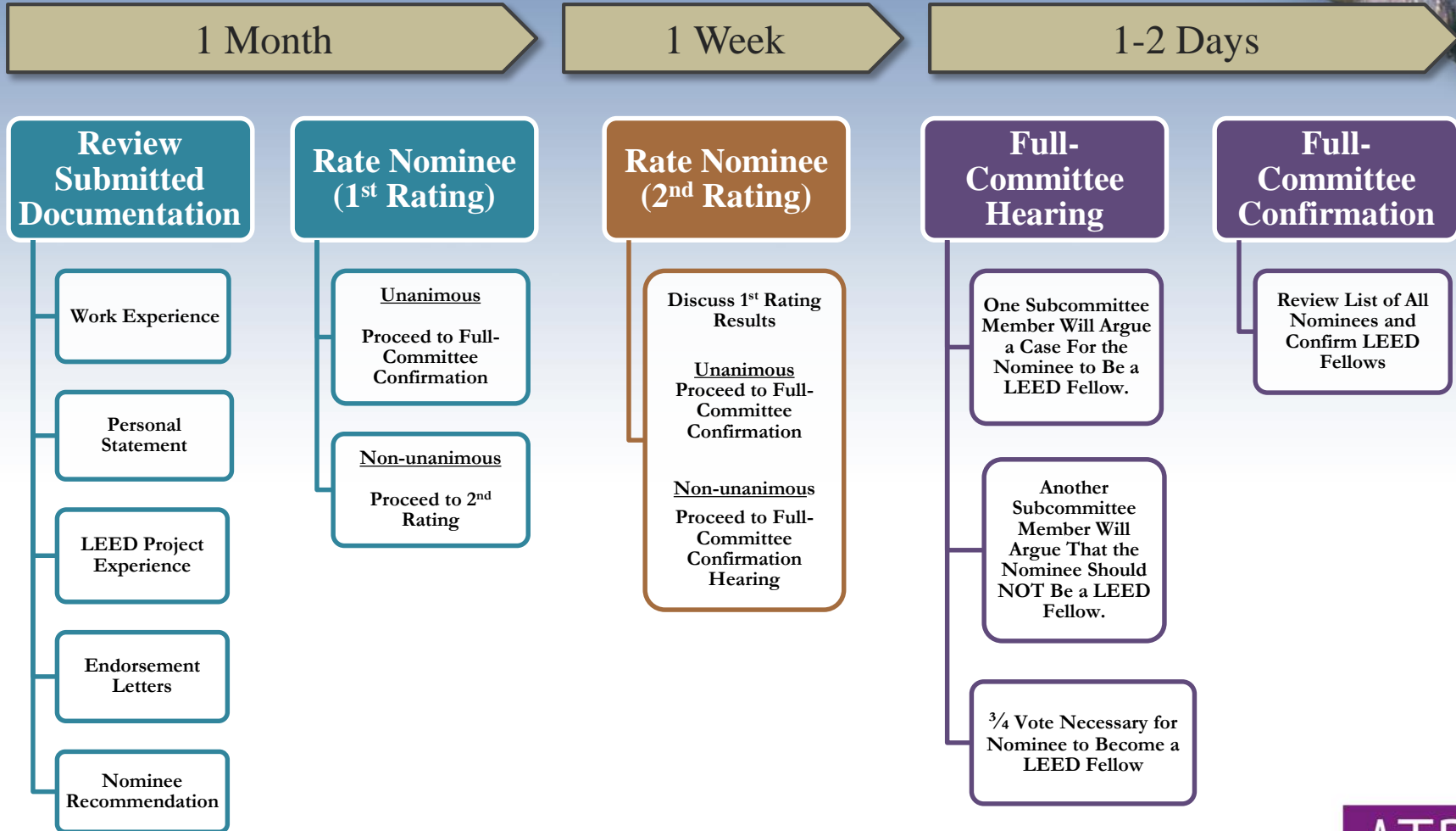

- Submit nomination fee: \$225.00
- Personal Statement of up to 4 pages (one-sided) pertaining to the mastery elements
- One-page (one-sided) LEED Project Experience letter of attestation
- Four 1-page (one-sided) Endorsement Letters on each mastery element. One endorsement letter required for Technical Proficiency. (*Use Endorsement Letter coversheets provided on the LEED Fellow portal)
- Click "Submit" on the last tab in the LEED Fellow portal

Nominator:

- Two-page (one-sided) Nominator Recommendation Statement for Nominee on the listed mastery elements
- Upload all (4) Endorsement Letters for Nominee
- Click "Submit" on the last tab in the LEED Fellow portal
